### Torrontés - Viognier

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**VINTAGE:** 2020

**TERROIRS:** Produced from vineyards at 1,700 m.a.s.l. near the town of Cafayate, in the up and coming wine region of Calchaquí Valley.

**ELABORATION:** Maceration in press with dry ice for 4 hours. Long, cool fermentation 25 days at 14 C°. No malolactic fermentation for either varietal, and aged without oak.

**TASTING NOTES:** Torrontés is famous throughout Argentina for its floral fruit, while Viognier, harvested early, brings aromas of apricot, pear and violets, making a very complex, fresh and unique wine. Bad Brothers ToVio offers an excellent balance of acidity and freshness with floral overtones typical of high altitude vineyards, while also delivering a wine with a rich, expansive palate replete with flavors of stone fruit and oranges. The color is an intense yellow with hints of green-gold.
